STUDENT CENTRIC METHODS FOR TEACHING

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1. EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING

Experiential learning is an educational orientation aimed at integrating theoretical and practical elements of learning that emphasizes the importance of experience for learning. In nursing education, learning through experience is called “hands-on” learning, or learning by doing.

FIELD VISIT:

Every program of UG and PG as per their course objectives we are providing them experiential learning in the form of field visit/educational visits. The main objective of educational visit to provide first-hand information through direct observation about place, object, activities, process in their natural settings to the students for learning.

EXHIBITION:

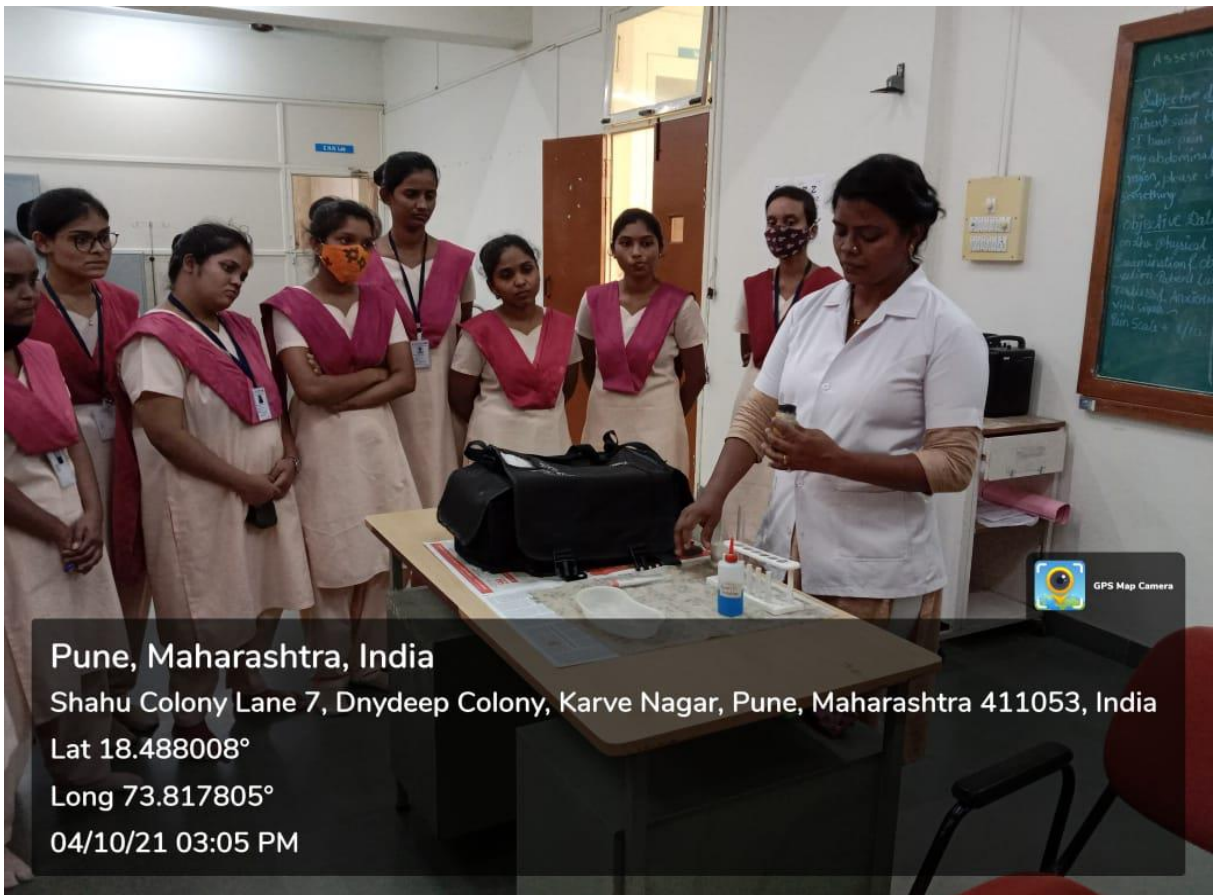

Microteaching is a training technique which requires student teacher to teach a single concept using specified teaching skill to a number of pupils in a short duration of time.



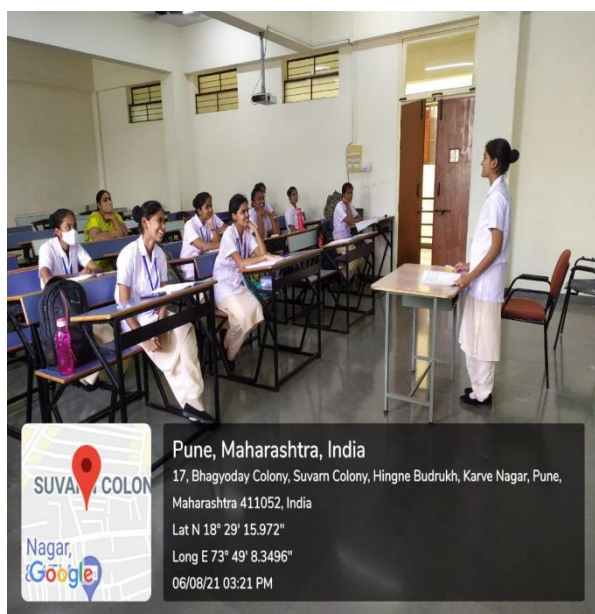
GROUP PROJECT:

AUDIOVISUAL AIDS:

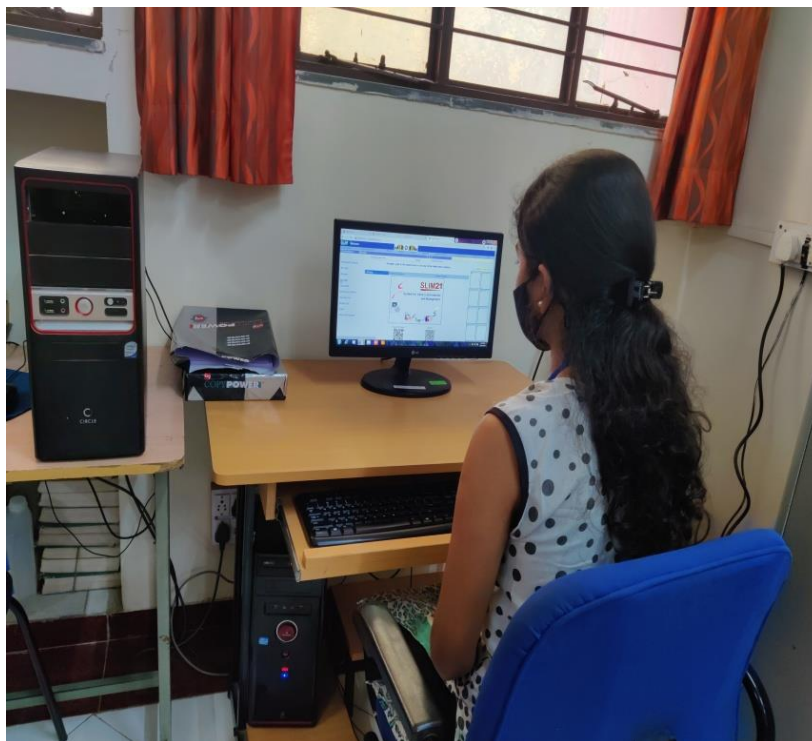
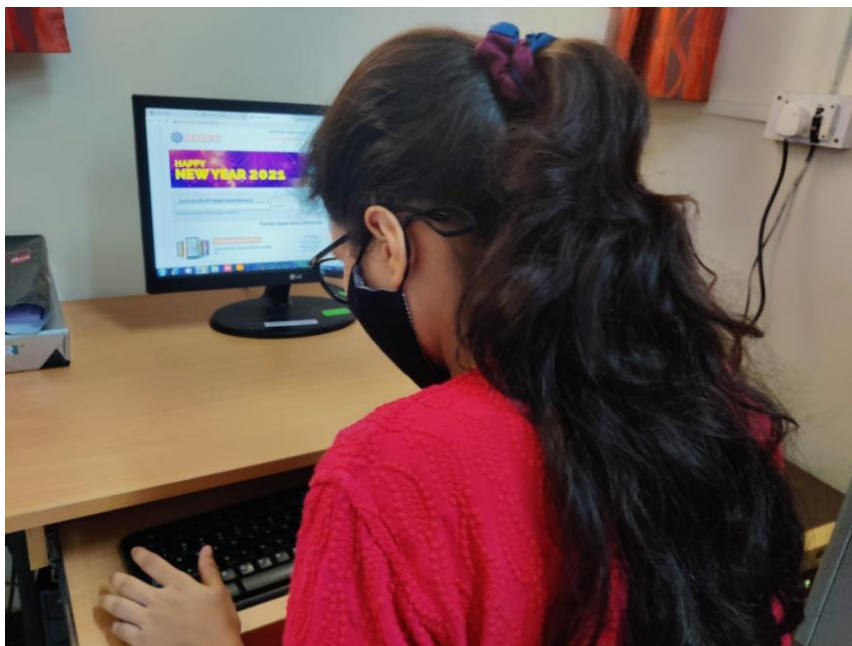

ONLINE LIBRARY ACCESSES:

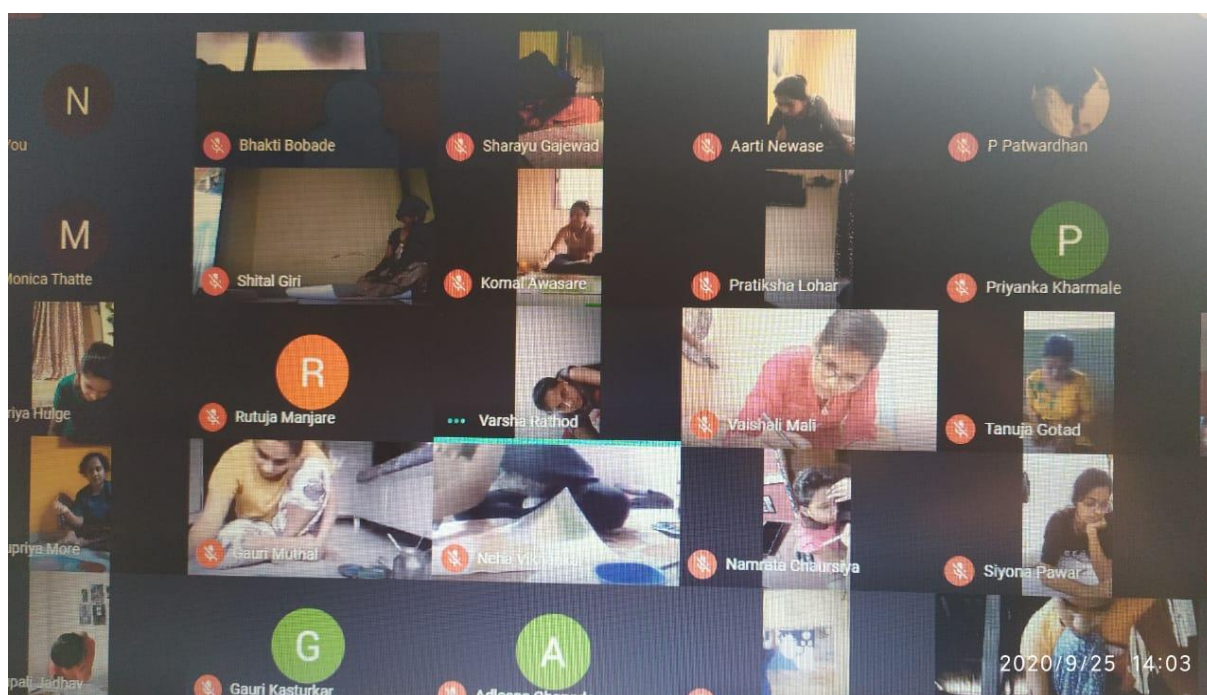
We make are library online to accesses by goggle drive which can help the all members of institution to accesses the library any time and utilize the information whichever is needed.

3. PROBLEM SOLVING:

BHAUBEEJ NIDHI : CELEBRATING THE CENTURY OF GRATITUDE

Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha was established at Pune by Bharatratna Maharshi Dhondo Keshav Karve in 1896 for empowerment of women. Since last 123 years, Samstha is working in the field of women's education and also has progressed in to the cities of Wai, Satara, Ratnagiri, Nagpur, Kamshet and Wasai. Today, through its 62 units Samstha is successfully imparting quality education to 35000 girls to make them self-sufficient.

Brief History : In 1919, late Mr. G. M. Chipalunkar started this innovative scheme of BhaubeejNidhi, in which many donors from the society give help to educate girls from economically backward families, from rural and far-flung regions where education is not available easily. Some of them are orphaned, having single parents or whose families are unable to take care of them. BhaubeejNidhi helps them by facilitating their admission in our schools and hostels. Lakhs (hundred thousands) of needy girls have obtained education because of the help obtained through this scheme. Many of them are working at high positions in the reputed organizations. Every year, because of this scheme more than 3800 girls are benefitted and get help to complete their education.

Objective and Expenditure:

- For helping the needy and deserving daughters of unsupported, single working mothers who become vulnerable in today's unsecured social environment.
- The needy and deserving girls aspiring for school and college education, but are facing problems in paying the high costs of education owing to the financial difficulties of the family.

These units are located at Pune, Satara, Wai, Ratnagiri, Nagpur & Karshet. All these units are meant only for girls or women.

Mahilashram Hostel

Mahilashram Hostel has been catering the needs of the girls from all over Maharashtra for more than 110 years. Mahilashram Hostel has different divisions according to the age group of the girls. The divisions include Varubai Hostel and two buildings of Rama Sadan.

The girls in the Mahilashram Hostel are provided with healthy food. Samstha ensures their overall development through Yoga and outdoor games under the supervision of trained teachers. All festivals are celebrated so as to maintain homely atmosphere in the hostel. The Samstha has a separate Medical Department with full time Medical Officer available for all the hostels.

The Mahilashram Hostel as of now has around 1500 girls in the hostel who are from Std.5th to Std.12th. Out of these girls around 500 girls are under total or partial parenthood of Samstha.

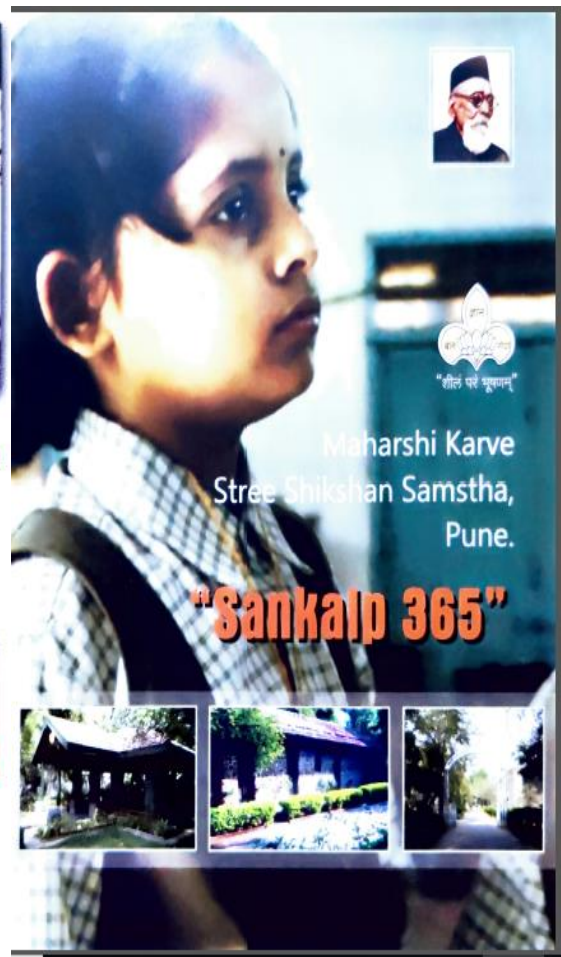
