Introduction:

Mouth hygiene is the practice of keeping one's mouth clean and free of disease, by regular brushing and cleaning in between the teeth. It is important oral hygiene is completed on a regular basis, as it can prevent dental disease from occurring. The most common types of dental disease is dental decay (also known as dental caries), gingivitis and periodontitis.Regular brushing consists of brushing twice a day after breakfast and before going to bed. Cleaning in between your teeth is called interdentally cleaning and it is equally important as tooth brushing.^[11] This is because a toothbrush cannot reach between your teeth, therefore only cleaning 50% of the surfaces. There are many tools to clean between the teeth; these include floss, flossettes, interdental brushes, wood sticks and gum picks. It is generally up to each individual to choose which tool they would prefer to use.

Mouth /oral hygiene is an essential aspect of human hygiene. Oral hygiene prevents halitosis as well as many other diseases that affect the heart and brain. LECTURE ON SICKLE CELL DISEASES

Introduction:

Sickle cell disease or sickle cell anemia, inherited disorder of the blood in which the oxygen-carrying hemoglobin pigments in erythrocytes (red blood cells) is abnormal. This hemoglobin-S crystallizes in small capillaries, where the concentration of oxygen in the blood is low (but sufficient for normal hemoglobin), causing the red blood cells to assume distorted, sickle like shapes. Linus Pauling discovered the chemical abnormality of the hemoglobin molecule that causes the erythrocyte sickling in 1949.

The sickled red blood cells tend to clog small blood vessels, depriving the tissues they serve of blood and oxygen. Painful crises result, with symptoms depending on the site affected (e.g., joint and abdominal pain or kidney damage). Strokes or seizures can occur if the brain is affected. Lung infections resulting from the patient's disinclination to take painful deep breaths are a frequent complication. In addition, the sickled erythrocytes are fragile and subject to rupture and destruction, leading to hemolytic anemia (reduction of oxygen-carrying hemoglobin caused by premature destruction of red blood cells) and such symptoms as fatigue, jaundice, and headaches.

The NSS volunteers of MKSSS Smt.BakulTambat institute of nursing education were attended lecture of anemia which is taken by Dr Kulkarni(Jankalyan raktpedhi) at BNCA hall he explained all the types of anemia with prevention and treatment of it. Declining CSR is also indicative of pre-birth discrimination manifested through gender biased sex selection and post birth discrimination against girls (in terms of health care, nutrition and educational opportunities).

In this scenario, Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, as one of the flagship programmes of the Government, to address the declining Child Sex Ratio and related issues of empowerment of women on a life-cycle continuum. It is a tri-ministerial, convergent effort of Ministries of Women and Child Development, Health & Family Welfare and Human Resource Development with a focus on awareness and advocacy campaign for changing mindsets, multi-sectoral action in selected 100 distrixts (1st Phase) +61 districts (IInd Phase) (low on CSR), enabling girls' education and effective enforcement of Pre-Conception & Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PC&PNDT) Act. The Hon'ble Prime Minister officially announced the expansion of BBBP Scheme covering all 640 districts as per Census 2011on March 8, 2018, at Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan through multi-sectoral intervention and District media & advocacy in 405 Districts. The remaining 235 Districts are covered under media advocacy and outreach. The Scheme is being administered through District Appropriate Authority and funds are directly transferred to the concerned District.

- Prevent gender biased sex selective elimination
- Ensure survival & protection of the girl child
- Ensuring education and participation of the girl child.

The Census, 2011 has shown significant declining trend in Child Sex Ratio (CSR), with 918 girls per 1000 boys in the age group of 0-6 years. The unabated decline in CSR since 1961 (from 976 in 1961 to 927 in 2001 and 918 in 2011) is a matter of grave concern as it reflects the low status of women in our society and indicates her disempowerment over a life-cycle continuum. Declining CSR is also indicative of pre-birth discrimination manifested through gender biased sex selection and post birth discrimination against girls (in terms of health care, nutrition and educational opportunities).

In this scenario, Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, as one of the flagship programmes of the Government, to address the declining Child Sex Ratio and related issues of empowerment of women on a life-cycle continuum. It is a tri-ministerial, convergent effort of Ministries of Women and Child Development, Health & Family Welfare and Human Resource Development with a focus on awareness and advocacy campaign for changing mindsets, multi-sectoral action in selected 100 distrixts (Ist Phase) +61 districts (IInd Phase) (low on CSR), enabling girls' education and effective enforcement of Pre-Conception & Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PC&PNDT) Act.

The Hon'ble Prime Minister officially announced the expansion of BBBP Scheme covering all 640 districts as per Census 2011on March 8, 2018, at Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan through multi-sectoral intervention and District media & advocacy in 405 Districts. The remaining 235 Districts are covered under media advocacy and outreach. The Scheme is



being administered through the District Appropriate Authority and funds are directly transferred to the concerned District.

Objectives of the Scheme

- Prevent gender biased sex selective elimination
- Ensure survival & protection of the girl child
- Ensuring education and participation of the girl child.

The Census, 2011 has shown a significant declining trend in Child Sex Ratio (CSR), with 918 girls per 1000 boys in the age group of 0-6 years. The unabated decline in CSR since 1961 (from 976 in 1961 to 927 in 2001 and 918 in 2011) is a matter of grave concern as it reflects the low status of women in our society and indicates her disempowerment over a life-cycle continuum. Declining CSR is also indicative of pre-birth discrimination manifested through gender-biased sex selection and post-birth discrimination against girls (in terms of health care, nutrition and educational opportunities).

In this scenario, Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao (BBBP) was launched by the Hon'ble Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, as one of the flagship programmes of the Government, to address the declining Child Sex Ratio and related issues of empowerment of women on a life-cycle continuum. It is a tri-ministerial, convergent effort of Ministries of Women and Child Development, Health & Family Welfare and Human Resource Development with a focus on awareness and advocacy campaign for changing mindsets, multi-sectoral action in selected 100 distrixts (Ist Phase) +61 districts (IInd Phase) (low on CSR), enabling girls' education and effective enforcement of Pre-Conception & Pre Natal Diagnostic Techniques (PC&PNDT) Act. The Hon'ble Prime Minister officially announced the expansion of BBBP Scheme covering all 640 districts as per Census 2011on March 8, 2018, at Jhunjhunu, Rajasthan through multi-sectoral intervention and District media & advocacy in 405 Districts. The remaining 235 Districts are covered under media advocacy and outreach. The Scheme is being administered through the District Appropriate Authority and funds are directly transferred to the concerned District.

Objectives of the Scheme

- Prevent gender-biased sex selective elimination
- Ensure survival & protection of the girl child
- - Ensuring education and participation of the girl child.
