MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement is between Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha, Pune, India and "Research Unit – Medical Research in Developing countries UNESCO Chair in Bioethics" University of Applied Sciences and Arts Hannover (UNESCO – HSH), Faculty III Media, Information and Design and Sumati Deshmukh Institute of Foreign Languages (SDIFL)

The two institutions agree to engage in an exchange and cooperation program as follows:

Purpose and Requirements:

The two institutions shall commence cooperation in the following field:

a. Student exchange program: India - Germany Cultural Exchange Program

The present agreement is not restricted to the field of collaboration mentioned above and could also include other fields or other forms of collaboration as agreed to by both parties.

This will enable students from both institutions to derive increased benefits provided by a change of cultural and educational venue.

Students visiting the host institution for the duration between a week and three months shall be subject to the same rules and regulations that the host institution requires from its own students, and shall also be subject to their home institution's rules and regulations. Exchange students shall also be recipients of all the privileges and rights that are normally accorded to the students of the host institution.

Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samsthashall encourage its own students to acquire a working knowledge of the German language before engaging in an exchange program which requires substantial class attendance in German. HsH shall do the same regarding the English Language for its own students wishing to join cultural exchange program or internship program for a substantial period.

To enable faculty members from both institutions to share information and to engage in collaborative research.

Faculty members wishing to visit the host institution for a semester or a year shall be subject to the rules and regulations of both institutions pertaining to this issue. The host institution shall attempt to assist faculty in securing housing and medical insurance.

Both institutions shall attempt to keep each other abreast of developments that may affect the cooperative programs that the two institutions are engaged in.

Number of Students

Up to 25 students may go to each institute for a period of one week to three months under cultural exchange program. Whilst equivalent numbers may be difficult to achieve, each institution will exercise maximum effort to achieve balance at the end of each third year.

Responsibility of the Institution:

The two institutions shall not be responsible for any charges incurred for rooming, boarding, insurance and travel, as these are responsibilities of the student(s) concerned.

Responsibility of the Student:

Students shall be responsible for their accommodation dookings, personal delongings and all costs related to travel, accommodation, insurance, food and incidental expenses. Students shall be responsible for cleaning with their advisors which courses are to be taken at the host institution.

Duration of Agreement:

This Agreement shall be of a 3-year duration commencing 2 March 2016. It may be renewed by mutual consent, thereafter. Should either party wish to terminate this Agreement, notification should be given to the other party one year prior to the proposed date of termination. Termination shall not affect those students or faculty who have been accepted for exchange.
