## MAHARSHI KARVE STREE SHIKSHAN SAMSTHA (MKSSS)

The Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha, a 127 years old parent body has been committed to, **“Empowerment of Women Through Education”** for over a century. The samstha works relentlessly towards educating the women and thereby making them self-reliant. It was established in 1896 by the great visionary and social worker **Bharat Ratna Maharshi Dhondo Keshav Karve** to provide shelter to destitute women. He founded the first women’s university (now known as Srimati Nathibai Damodar Thackersey (SNDT) Women's University) in India. He continued working for women's education throughout his life, overcoming several challenges. **He received the highest civilian honor “Bharat Ratna” in 1958.**

## FACULTY

## ASSESSMENT

Internal assessments are done at the institute level based on assignments, theory, and practical examinations. Students have to pass internal and external examinations separately. The passing percentage for the both is 50%. For Auxiliary Nurse Midwife (ANM) and General Nursing Midwifery (GNM) final assessment/examinations are conducted by MSBNPE, Mumbai and for B.Sc Nursing, Post Basic B.Sc Nursing, M.Sc Nursing final assessment/examinations are conducted by MUHS, Nashik.

## STANDARD OF PASSING

Each student has to undergo 100% clinical experience hours and 80% theory hours prescribed by INC, New Delhi, MSBNPE, Mumbai and MUHS, Nashik to qualify for semester / annual / final exams.

## AWARD OF DEGREE AND REGISTRATION

Candidates after successful completion of program will be awarded Diploma or Degree Certificate and they are eligible for registration with Maharashtra Nursing Council.

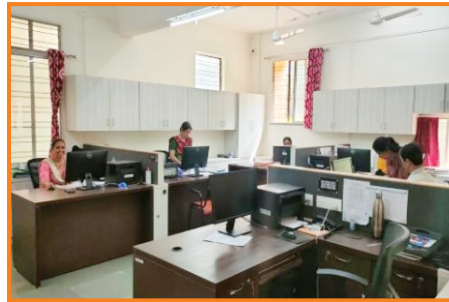
## RAGGING

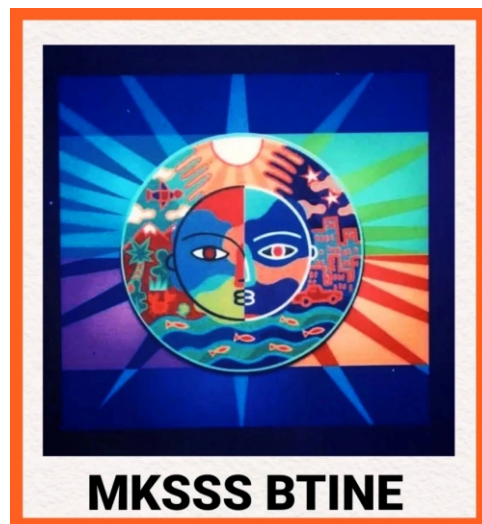
