Experienced Faculty: A Catalyst for Excellence and Growth

Experienced faculty play a critical role in enhancing the quality of education and supporting the growth of an institution. Their ability, leadership, and mentorship shape the academic and clinical training environment, improving student success and institutional reputation.

The institute has a Principal since its start and under her leadership and guidance, the institute has grown and expanded, having all nursing programs including diploma, UG, PG, and PhD. Our principal is an active member at BoS, ethical committees of other nursing institutes, and a member of the perspective plan committee at MNC and MUHS. Our principal received awards for excellence, Best Principal, and TNAI lifetime achievement award. Our faculty have 22 to 10 years of continuous service in the institute. The institute is the founder and the organizer of the Private Nursing Colleges Association, Maharashtra since 2008, (AMUNC) and hosts regular meetings.

The Institute places a strong emphasis on:

1. Enhancing educational quality and curriculum development:

The institute integrates the prescribed curricula, with evidence-based practices and emerging trends, while fostering critical thinking and clinical decision-making in students using various innovative teaching-learning methods. e.g., project, peer tutoring, jigsaw classrooms, and case unfolding... Faculty use basic and advanced nursing labs and equipment to prepare students for real-life healthcare situations. e.g., simulation, mastery learning, OSCE, DOP, and case discussion.... Faculty seek ongoing feedback from stakeholders to adapt the curricula to meet evolving healthcare needs. They also collaborate across disciplines to enhance the holistic development of students. Our institute has active MoUs with other nursing institutes and healthcare organizations.

2. Effective clinical training:

With hands-on clinical experience, faculty guide the students through practical training, helping them develop essential skills such as patient assessment and treatment planning. Faculty stay updated by attending various training programs on simulation organized by INC and various national and international conferences to enhance clinical skills. Clinical experts train trainers on simulation at our institute.

3. Mentorship and guidance:

Faculty with years of experience as mentors, provide individualized support to students. They offer, emotional support, and practical advice on dealing with the challenges of the nursing profession along with valuable career guidance. Also, they guide students through complex clinical situations and help them develop critical thinking and critical thinking skills. The institute has a 1:10 ratio for mentor mentees keeps a logbook for each student and provides remedial measures for slow and advanced learners.

4. Student success and career advancement:

Faculty show professionalism and instill leadership skills and a keen sense of ethics, contributing to holistic student development of students. Support from the experienced faculty has increased the student engagement and success of the institute. The institute has implemented the ISO systems and achieved NAAC A Grade because of the faculty commitment. Faculty motivate the students for higher education. Graduates from institutes are competent and confident, leading to better employment rates and success in their academics and clinical skills. Our students are placed globally in good nursing positions.

5. Research, funding and innovation:

Institutes organize conferences, and FDPs at the national international level with unique themes for the upliftment of faculty and students. 


