MAHARASHTRA UNIVERSITY OF HEALTH SCIENCES, NASHIK

Direction No. 01/2009 : Rules and terms & conditions governing for demanding of revaluation of answerbooks of the final University Theory examinations of the under graduate courses by the students".

Whereas the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act 1998 (Maharashtra Act No. X of 1999) has come into force with effect from 03rd June 1998.

AND

Whereas the University has since decided to carry out revaluation of answerbooks of the University Theory examinations of the under graduate courses on demand by the desired students.

AND

Whereas it is essential to frame rules and terms & conditions governing for demanding of revaluation of answerbooks of the University Theory examinations of the students of the under graduate courses enrolled with the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

AND

Whereas the rules and terms & conditions governing for demanding for revaluation of answerbooks of the University Theory examinations of the students of the under graduate courses are not in existence.

AND

Whereas necessary provision in the University Ordinance for carrying out revaluation of answerbooks of the University Theory examinations of the students of the under graduate courses are yet to be made.

1. Now, therefore I, Dr. Mrudula A. Phadke, Vice-Chancellor of the University in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under sub-Section 8 of Section 16 of Maharashtra University of Health Sciences Act 1998, issue the Direction for framing rules and terms & conditions governing for demanding of revaluation of answerbooks of University final examinations of the students of the under graduate courses based on the following provisions/resolutions :-

- a) Clause 31 (1) of MUHS Act 1998.
- b) Clause No. 1.15, 61 & 66 of Ordinance 1/2002.
- c) JBVC meeting decision dt. 16.11.2004
- d) BOE resolution No. 77 (b)/2008 dt. 06/10/2008.
- e) Management Council resolution dt. 05/02/2009.

2. Whereas it is expedient to lay down the procedure for carrying out **revaluation of theory answerbooks** (B & C Sections) of the students of University final examinations of all the undergraduate courses.

3. This Direction shall be called " **Rules and terms & conditions governing for demanding of revaluation of answerbooks of the final University Theory examinations of the under graduate courses by the students**".

4. The revaluation of answerbook system will now come into force with effect from **Nov./Dec. 2008 examinations**.

5. The eligibility and criteria conditions for the revaluation of answerbooks facility will be as under :-

Eligibility :-

- a) The revaluation of answerbooks facility will be operative with effect from **Nov./Dec. 2008 examinations**.
- b) An examinee will be entitled to apply for revaluation of theory paper answerbook(s) in prescribed form alongwith requisite fees.
- c) **Practical exam papers of the students will not be revaluated** since the practical exams are conducted based on the clinical examination/practical knowledge of the concerned subject.

Procedure for application

- a) An examinee alone hereafter referred to, as '**student**' shall be entitled to apply for revaluation of his/her theory subject answerbook(s).
- b) The student desirous of revaluation of his/her answerbook(s) shall be required to apply in the prescribed form (**Appendix 'A'**) as per the format enclosed with this Direction.
- c) The student shall have to submit application for revaluation of answerbook(s) **within 10 days from the date of declaration of the respective results on the website**.
- d) The student has to submit application at the same college where he/she had submitted the exam form of the concerned exam.
- e) The colleges will ensure that the application forms for revaluation of answerbooks reach to the University **within 15 days from declaration of the respective results**.
- f) Application forms of the students for revaluation of answerbooks received after due date shall not be accepted by the concerned college. The colleges will be having **05 days** with them to deposit the application forms at University.
- g) The answerbook revaluation fees will be @ **Rs. 1,100/- per subject** as per the decision of the Management Council resolution dt. 05/02/2009.
- h) Application form shall be accompanied by the **non-refundable fees** as may be prescribed by the University from time to time payable by way of demand draft, drawn in favour of '**The Registrar, MUHS, Nashik**'.

- i) The application form must be accompanied by a xerox copy of the web marksheet of the concerned exam (marklist of the student which is being displayed on University website at the time of declaration of results).
- j) The Dean/Principal of the concerned college on receipt of such application(s) from the students will submit to the University alongwith the demand drafts of fees immediately in batches as per the course/yearwise declaration of the results. However, the colleges shall not accept the application(s) after the cut-off-date (10 days after declaration of results). In any case the University will not accept the late submitted application forms and if any legal implications arised later, the responsibility will rest with the concerned college only.
- k) The revised results in case of any changes in the previous results will be displayed on University website. Subsequently the revised marksheets will be sent to the concerned college.
- l) The request for revaluation of answerbook(s) is an additional facility extended to the students by the University. Therefore, in case of any delay in the revaluation process due to any administrative/technical reason (beyond the control of the University) shall not confer any right upon the student(s) to claim any kind of relief/benefit.
- m) The revised results after the revaluation shall be final which shall be binding on the concerned student.
