Module Overview: This module covers various basic first aid techniques including basic CPR and common emergencies. It further aims to train students to develop first aid competencies to deal with specific emergencies to preserve life.



INTRODUCTION: -

MKSSS BTINE had arranged First Aid management workshop from 6th December 2024 to 11th December 2024 for Semester-I B.Sc. Nursing Students. It was a 40 hours module on First Aid Management and was arranged by our HOD Dr. Shubhada Ponkshe and Semester- I B.Sc. Nursing department.

First aid is the first and immediate assistance given to any person suffering from either a minor or serious illness or injury, with care provided to preserve life, prevent the condition from worsening, or to promote recovery. It includes initial intervention in a serious condition prior to professional medical help being available, such as performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) while waiting for an ambulance, as well as the complete treatment of minor conditions, such as applying a bandage to a wound. A First aid is generally performed by someone with basic medical training. Mental health first aid is an extension of the concept of first aid to cover mental health, while psychological first aid is used as early treatment of people who are at risk for developing Post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).

FIRST AID MANAGEMENT: -

At any moment around you, you could experience an injury or illness. Using basic first aid you may be able to stop a minor mishap from getting worst in the case of a serious medical emergency, you may even save a life.

That's why it's so importance to learn basic first aid skills.

Day 1 – 18th November 2024

A “Palliative Care Module” refers to or is designed to help students to develop in-depth knowledge, competencies, and a positive approach to providing quality palliative care to persons suffering from chronic illnesses and resultant health problems in a variety of settings, collaborating supportive services. The Indian Nursing Council (INC) update regarding integrating Palliative Care into the UG nursing curriculum from the 2022 batch. According to the latest syllabus, a 20-hours mandatory module on Palliative Care is included in the 4th semester B.Sc. Nursing Course. INC implies that the module is designed to help students develop in depth knowledge, competencies, and a positive approach to providing quality palliative care to persons suffering from chronic illnesses and resultant health problems in various settings, collaborating with supportive services.

9.00 AM- 11.00 AM : Introduction of Palliative Care

During this session, Ms. Vrushali Kalkutagi led an in-depth about the Introduction to the “Palliative Care Module”. Palliative care(PC) is an effective model for relieving pain and other symptoms and ensuring the quality of care. Through the units of this module, we shall look at the approach and gain knowledge, skills, a favorable attitude towards providing compassionate and quality palliative care. Because Nurses are often considered the heart of healthcare because they play a vital role in providing compassionate and competent care to patients.

11.00 AM- 1.00 PM : Nursing management of symptoms holistic approach and pain management palliative Care:

During this session, Mrs. Samina Mulani led an in-depth about the Nursing management of symptoms holistic approach and pain management palliative Care. Patient descriptions of physical symptoms and their severity are the primary data for symptom assessment in palliative care. Exploring patients' reports of symptoms requires thoroughness, persistence, and patience, a fundamental aspect of palliative care. Symptom assessment usually involves taking a detailed history from the patient to understand the cause and severity of the symptoms.

Holistic care focuses on the whole person, not just the condition. It looks at how the individual is dealing with the situation, their physical, psychological, social and spiritual domains of health and any issues they are experiencing. The assessment of symptoms is a vital aspect of nursing care to provide comfort and enhance the quality of life.

Severe chronic pain, including cancer pain, can be managed well through a systematic approach. For example, adequate pain relief can be achieved in 70 to 90 percent of patients if proper treatment guidelines for cancer pain are followed. WHO analgesic ladder is a simple protocol for treating chronic pain. The WHO Pain Ladder is a set of guidelines for the management of pain, developed by the World Health Organization (WHO) in 1986. It is a widely accepted approach for the treatment of pain in patients, particularly those with cancer.

1.00 PM- 2.00 PM : Lunch

2.00 PM- 4.00 PM : Nursing management of minor symptoms and caregiver role strain :

During this session, Ms. Vaishali Patil led an in-depth about the Nausea and vomiting can cause patients and their relative's great distress. Its management includes Avoid smells that cause nausea, e.g., the smell of cooking, phenol, Dettol, etc. Keep a bowl for vomiting close by. Give small portions of food at frequent intervals instead of big meals at one time. Constipation occurs when bowel movements become difficult or less frequent. Constipation is a common problem in palliative care, affecting up to 90% of patients receiving palliative care. Its management includes Stimulant laxatives are the first choice of laxatives for prevention and treatment. It also includes Prevention of constipation.

Dyspnea, Diarrhea, Maintaining, correcting nutrition is a significant problem in terminally ill patients, particularly when suffering from advanced malignant disease, Fatigue, Powerlessness, Anxiety, Social Isolation, Spiritual Distress, Impaired Physical Mobility, Self-Care Deficit, Delirium. Students able to understand management of such minor symptoms. Consider the patient's need for assistive devices. Recognize choice for food, personal care items, and other things. Evaluate gag reflex prior to initial oral feeding. Verify the need for home health care after discharge. Provide privacy during dressing. Identify the cause, including the precipitating, aggravating, and palliating factors. Provide pharmacological and non-pharmacological management. Providing a safe environment and reassuring the patient that we keep them safe. Communicate with the patient and family calmly, with a non-judgmental attitude, and use simple terms, are the nursing management of patients with minor symptoms. Family members close to the patient may play the role of caregiver.

4.00 PM- 5.00 PM : Demonstration of Procedures of Palliative Care

During this demonstration session, all teachers were with students for procedures such as Bladder care, Lymphoedema Management, Assisting in Indwelling Ascitic Catheter Placement, Assisting In Thoracocentesis, Subcutaneous injection, Colostomy Care, Pressure ulcers Management, Wound Care which are the procedures performed by students.

Day 2 – 19th November 2024

9.00 AM- 11.00 AM : Communication Skills In Palliative Care :

During this session, Mrs. Dipali Awate led an in-depth about Communication Skills and its importance in Palliative Care nursing. Communication is exchanging ideas or feelings between two or more people on a common background or agenda. Communication can be verbal or non-verbal. Good communication is a skill that ensures improvement. Good communication is essential for ensuring the patient's needs are understood and can be met by the healthcare team. Good communication allows the nurses to connect with the patients and those who are important to them, understand their priorities and wishes, and support them to make informed decisions about their care. Reflect on your conversations and think about what went well and what you could do better next time.

11.00 AM- 1.00 PM : Nursing management of symptoms holistic approach and pain management palliative Care:

During this session, Mrs. Samina Mulani led an in-depth about the Nursing management of symptoms holistic approach and pain management palliative Care. Assess pain characteristics using PQRST of Pain. Assess for signs and symptoms associated with chronic pain such as fatigue, decreased appetite, weight loss, changes in body posture, sleep pattern disturbance, anxiety, irritability, restlessness, or depression. Assess the patient's perception of the effectiveness of methods used for pain relief in the past. Evaluate gender, cultural, societal and religious factors that may influence the patient's pain experience and response to pain relief. Positioning, reassurance, good communication, psychological support, joint mobility (passive & active), spiritual counselling, diversion therapy, art or music therapy, etc., are also useful.

1.00 PM- 2.00 PM : Lunch

2.00 PM- 4.00 PM - Optimization of Care :

During this session, Ms. Dhanashree Patil led an in-depth about the Optimization of care. Optimization of care refers to improving the quality of healthcare services and increasing efficiency. Optimization of care in end-of-life care involves ensuring that patients receive the best possible care to meet their physical, emotional, social and spiritual needs. This may involve a range of interventions, including pain and symptom management, emotional support, and spiritual care.

Also includes Quality of life, Essential care, . Anticipatory prescription, Dying with dignity, . Care during the terminal phase, Care of the dying person, Collective decision making.

4.00 PM- 5.00 PM : Demonstration of Palliative Care Procedures

During this demonstration session, all teachers were with students for procedures such as Tracheostomy Care, Naso-Gastric Tube Management, Mouth care/ Oral Hygiene which are the procedures performed by the students.

Day 3 – 20th November 2024

9.00 AM- 10.00 AM : Examination on Palliative Care Module

10.00 AM- 12.00 PM : Demonstration of Palliative Care Procedures:

During this demonstration session, all teachers were with students for procedures such as Subcutaneous injection, Colostomy Care, Pressure ulcers Management, Wound Care which are the procedures performed by the students.
