Venue: Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital, Pune.

Total number of students: 50 students

Date: 28/12/2024 (roll no. 26 to 50) and 29/12/2024 (roll no. 01 to 25)

Time: 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

We MKSSS BTINE had arranged Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) for the First Semester B.Sc. Nursing students as a part of revised curriculum of this program. This curriculum is updated by the MUHS and INC. The OSCE Skill stations were arranged for the First Semester B.Sc. Nursing students on 28/12/2024 and 29/12/2024. There were total 48 students of A- Batch and 01 student of B-Batch who participated in the OSCE. The class was divided into two groups of 25 students. The OSCE session was carried out on assessment of Temperature, Pulse and Respiration in the Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital, Pune.

For conducting OSCE on assessment of Temperature, Pulse and Respiration total 4 stations were arranged:

- Station- I:- Hand washing
- Station- II:- Assembling of articles
- Station- III:- Assessment of Temperature, Pulse and Respiration and Blood Pressure
- Station- IV:- Feedback

Before conducting the actual OSCE, everything about the OSCE, how to perform, what all are the stations, what students are supposed to do it was explained to all the students. The students were told to go through all the stations, to perform assessment of Temperature, Pulse and Respiration procedure. They were evaluated on the basis of their skills and knowledge related to the particular procedure. Evaluation checklist was prepared for OSCE evaluation.



At station-I students were expected to perform hand hygiene and follow all the steps. At station-II students were supposed to arrange and assemble the articles which are required for their procedure. At station- III students were supposed to perform the actual steps of Temperature, Pulse and Respiration assessment procedure. At station- IV giving feedback from the examiner about students' performance was planned.

Students were allowed first to perform all the steps of the procedures and cover all the stations. After completing with their procedure the examiner/ evaluator gave them the timely feedback about their performance and points to be improved of the procedure. Dr. Shubhada Ponshe and Ms. Aaditi Shirke were the evaluators for the OSCE skill stations.

Topic: PARENTERAL DRUG ADMINISTRATION

Number of Stations: 5

TOTAL NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 48 students

Objectives

The OSCE aimed to assess students' competency in parenteral drug administration through a structured and timed examination.

The key objectives included:

- Identifying appropriate sites for drug administration.
- Performing accurate drug dosage calculations.
- Demonstrating correct techniques for withdrawing medication.
- Administering drugs via Intradermal (ID) and Subcutaneous (SC) routes.
- Ensuring patient safety through proper aseptic techniques and adherence to protocols.

Station breakdown and timing

1. Station 1: Critical Thinking Test (Unmanned) - 5 minutes

- Candidates were required to identify appropriate sites for parenteral drug administration.
- This station assessed students' theoretical knowledge and critical thinking regarding site selection for various routes of drug administration.

2. Station 2: Scenario-Based Drug Calculation (Unmanned) - 2 minutes

- This station involved drug dosage calculations based on given patient scenarios.
- It tested students' ability to accurately compute medication dosages, reinforcing the importance of precision in drug administration.



3. Station 3: Withdrawing Medicine from an Ampule and a Vial - 3 minutes

- Candidates demonstrated the correct techniques for withdrawing medication from both an ampule and a vial.
- The station emphasized aseptic techniques, proper use of syringes and needles, and safety precautions to prevent contamination or medication errors.

4. Station 4: Scenario-based drug administration (Intradermal and Subcutaneous, Intramuscular routes) - 2 minutes

- Students administered medication via Intradermal (ID) or Subcutaneous (SC) or Intramuscular (IM) routes based on a given scenario.
- This assessed their ability to follow correct procedures, maintain aseptic techniques, and ensure patient safety while performing drug administration.
- This assessed students' ability to demonstrate the correct technique for administering an Intradermal (ID) injection, Intradermal (ID) or Subcutaneous (SC) or Intramuscular (IM) routes based on a given scenario.
- The focus was on proper site selection, injection angle, volume control, and patient communication.

5. Station 5: Feedback session - 5 minutes

- Following the OSCE, a 5-minute feedback session was conducted to provide students with insights into their performance, highlighting strengths and areas for improvement.

Conclusion:

The OSCE provided a comprehensive evaluation of students' competencies in parenteral drug administration, emphasizing theoretical knowledge, practical skills, and critical thinking. The combination of unmanned and hands-on stations ensured a thorough assessment of essential clinical skills required for safe and effective drug administration.




Figure: Station I and II Critical thinking drug calculation and site Identification



