REPORT ON CLINICAL POSTING (2024-2025)

Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital and Research Center is a large multispecialty, tertiary care hospital located in Erandwane, Pune. It handles a wide range of medical and surgical patients. Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital (DMH) and Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha's (MKSSS) Smt. Bakul Tambat Institute of Nursing Education (BTINE) shares a 99-year collaborative bond, ensuring a long-term commitment to nursing education and clinical training. Being a parent hospital, all nursing students from BTINE are allowed to gain hands-on clinical experience at DMH.

The clinical posting schedule is planned and discussed in advance at the institute level to ensure proper coordination and to prevent any overlapping in clinical areas. The finalized schedule is then formally communicated to the Medical Director and the Nursing Director of Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital via email, along with an official permission letter and the duty roster for the students.

An orientation session was conducted for first-year nursing students at the beginning of their clinical posting. Sr. Saraswati led a detailed session on infection control practices, covering essential topics such as:

- Hand hygiene and personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Biomedical waste segregation and disposal
- Standard precautions and transmission-based precautions
- Prevention of hospital-acquired infections (HAIs)

This session helped students understand the importance of maintaining a safe and sterile hospital environment and prepared them to follow institutional protocols from day one.

Each posting is designed according to the specific learning objectives of the students' academic curriculum and year of study. The goal is to help students:

- Apply theoretical knowledge in real-life clinical situations.
- Develop essential nursing competencies in diverse care settings.
- Build professional confidence and ethical responsibility.

Students are systematically exposed to various clinical departments, including:

- Medical wards
- Surgical wards
- Orthopedics
- ENT and Eye units
- OPDs
- ICU and Emergency department
- Operation Theatres
- Pediatric and Obstetric units etc.

Faculty members from our institute accompany the students during postings to provide ongoing supervision, evaluation, and support.

As part of their clinical training, students also visited the Simulation Lab at Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital. Dr. Vaibhavi Upadhye conducted a comprehensive simulation-based training session for both students and faculty. The session focused on enhancing clinical decision-making, procedural skills, and emergency response through realistic, hands-on scenarios in a controlled learning environment.

Clinical activities performed:

Our nursing students were actively engaged in delivering patient care under the close supervision of clinical instructors. The primary objective was to provide them with meaningful hands-on experience in managing both medical and surgical cases, while fostering the development of critical thinking, clinical skills, and an understanding of hospital protocols. Responsibilities were assigned based on the individual needs of the patients and included the following activities:

- Monitoring and recording vital signs
- Assisting in hygiene care and daily living activities
- Medication administration under supervision
- Performing wound dressing and post-operative care
- Patient assessment and documentation in nursing notes
- Observing pre-, intra-, and post-operative procedures
- Participated in or observed several advanced nursing care activities- ventilatory care, oxygen therapy, emergency management, and use of monitoring equipment etc.

- Assisting in mobility and rehabilitation
- Providing health education to patients and caregivers.
- Infection control practices
- Nursing administration etc.

These nursing care activities enabled students to go beyond basic bedside care, improving their clinical judgment, confidence, and competence in handling complex patient needs. This clinical experience helped bridge the gap between theoretical knowledge and practical application in real healthcare settings. During the clinical posting, the overall patient response was positive. Patients appreciated the care provided by the student nurses and expressed satisfaction.

Final-year students underwent a structured internship program, during which they were given responsibilities appropriate to their level of training under faculty supervision.

In addition, students were supported in their placement process, with opportunities for employment at Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital. Most students received job offers during or immediately after the completion of their internship.

Blood Donation campaign.

Introduction

Blood donation is a vital part of worldwide healthcare. It allows for blood transfusion as a life-sustaining and life-saving procedure. Over one hundred million units of blood are donated each year throughout the world. This activity reviews donor eligibility and selection, adverse effects of donation, and pathogen reduction and inactivation for donated blood.

Blood donation for transfusion is a vital step in the management of many clinical problems, with the two primary indications being anemia and acute blood loss. Blood donation itself is also used to primarily treat a small subset of medical conditions. At the beginning of the 20th century, Karl Landsteiner identified ABO blood groups, at which time blood typing of individuals was only beginning to be adopted as a universally standard practice.

Due to the inability to prevent blood from clotting once removed from the donor and thus store and transfer blood to be delivered when needed later, transfusions were only carried out on a limited basis. Blood was transfused directly from donor to recipient without intervening storage or transport. This method worked for small numbers of patients and only on a small scale, as donors and recipients needed to be connected both in time and space. There was a time when lists of donors were maintained of persons locally available to be called in to donate to patients at any time as needed. Necessity drove the development of more flexible donation and storage practices when World War I began. "On-demand" blood donation was not feasible for such a large scale effort. Soldiers were dying of otherwise non-fatal wounds due mainly to the inability to perform a timely blood transfusion.



Activity.

MKSSS BTINE conducted Blood Donation at Ichalkaranji hall of Smt. Bakul Tambat Institute of Nursing Education, Pune. Camp organized by MKSSS BTINE'S NSS teachers and volunteers with Janklyan blood bank.

During the blood donation hemoglobin and blood group checking etc. activities were done. All 50 NSS volunteer were participated in this camp. Volunteers helped in this programme to the doctors for physical examination, checking vital signs, history taking and also assist to doctor during hemoglobin testing and blood screening.

Total 216 participants were registered in the camp out of 115 were eligible for donating blood. In this camp the NSS volunteers have given information to the participants about the importance of blood donation, prevention of Anemia.

After blood donation, the participants were given snacks & refreshments & were educated about the care to be taken after the donation was complete for next 24 hours. Confidentiality has maintained during and after treatment.



During the academic year 2024-25, a total of 137 students were posted at the Chaitanya Institute of Mental Health for their Mental Health Nursing posting. Faculty members also accompanied the students to provide supervision and guidance throughout the posting.

During their clinical experience, students came across various cases. As per the needs of the patients, students:

- Collected patient history.
- Performed Mental Status Examinations (MSE)
- Prepared workbooks based on their assessments.
- Assisted counsellors to learn and practice counselling techniques.

In addition to this, students actively engaged in therapeutic interventions such as:

- Group therapy
- Dance therapy
- Music therapy
- Games and recreational activities

They also organized recreational therapy sessions, including:

- Art and craft activities
- Storytelling
- Sports and indoor games
- Yoga sessions

These programs encouraged clients to participate actively, keeping them physically and mentally engaged. Clients showed great interest, requested for more activities, and exhibited positive outcomes as a result of participation.

Students also collaborated with the team of counsellors and professionals at the institute, who appreciated their efforts and actively participated in the programs. The exposure was a valuable learning experience for the students.

Furthermore, the students took part in the Mental Health Week celebrations organized by the institute. They planned and conducted several activities during the event. Notably, the VI Semester B.Sc. Nursing students won 1st Prize in the dance competition, showcasing their talent and enthusiasm.

Session 2: Structuring an effective research paper. By Dr. Dilip Kanhere Professor, Center for modeling and simulations, S.P. Pune University. 

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


ACTIVITY –

'FEMALE FETICIDE'

Introduction:

Female feticide is the process of finding out the sex of the foetus and undergoing abortion if it is a girl. Although it is illegal, many people continue to practice it. Besides this, there are some communities which practice female infanticide - the practice of killing the girl child once she is born. This fact is highlighted by the findings of census 2001 which show that there are only 933 women in this country for every 1000 men. Besides this, Census (2011) data showed a significant declining trend in the Child Sex Ratio (CSR) calculated as number of girls for every 1000 boys between age group of 0 - 6 years, with an all time low of 918 in 2011 from 976 in 1961. This decline in sex ratio means that we are not just depriving girls of human rights, we are also depriving them of their right to live.

INTRODUCTION

Rainfall pattern has also disturbed which causes drought in some areas and flooding in other areas. Ice caps and glaciers are melting continuously, and its level depends on the increased level of temperature. It is causing loss of habitat near to the poles and polar bears have greatly endangered. Wild animals living in the forest are endangered because of their habitat loss due to deforestation. Bleaching of Coral Reefs and loss of Plankton are done due to warming seas and acidification (carbonic acid formation). Various types of diseases are also spreading especially malaria to the nearby regions. Now, it has become very necessary for the countries worldwide especially developed countries to reduce their carbon emission as quickly as possible. We need to reduce its carbon emission to a great extent in order to solve the problem of global warming. 

ENVIRONMENTAL SANITATION

INTRODUCTION

Environmental sanitation includes managing solid waste and wastewater, and pest and vector control. Poor sanitation reduces human well-being, social and economic development due to impacts such as anxiety, risk of sexual assault, and lost opportunities for education and work. Poor sanitation is linked to transmission of diarrhoeal diseases such as cholera and dysentery, as well as typhoid, intestinal worm infections and polio. It exacerbates stunting and contributes to the spread of antimicrobial resistance. Open defecation perpetuates a vicious cycle of disease and poverty. The countries where open defecation is most widespread have the highest number of deaths of children aged under 5 years as well as the highest levels of malnutrition and poverty, and big disparities of wealth. Benefits of improved sanitation extend well beyond reducing the risk of diarrhoea. These include: 1. reducing the spread of intestinal worms, and trachoma, which are neglected tropical diseases that cause suffering for millions; 2. reducing the severity and impact of malnutrition; 3. promoting dignity and boosting safety, particularly among women and girls; 4. promoting school attendance: girls' school attendance is particularly boosted by the provision of separate sanitary facilities; 5. reducing the spread of antimicrobial resistance; 6. potential safe recovery of water, nutrients and renewable energy from wastewater and sludge; and 7. potential to increase overall community resilience to climate shocks, for example through safe use of wastewater for irrigation to mitigate water scarcity.

DENGUE AND CHICKUNGUNIA

INTRODUCTION

Dengue (break-bone fever) is a viral infection that spreads from mosquitoes to people. It is more common in tropical and subtropical climates. Most people who get dengue will not have symptoms. But for those who do, the most common symptoms are high fever, headache, body aches, nausea, and rash. Most will get better in 1-2 weeks. Some people develop severe dengue and need care in a hospital. In severe cases, dengue can be fatal. One can lower risk of dengue by avoiding mosquito bites especially during the day. Dengue is treated with pain medicine as there is no specific treatment currently. About half of the world's population is now at risk of dengue with an estimated 100-400 million infections occurring each year. Dengue is found in tropical and sub-tropical climates worldwide, mostly in urban and semi-urban areas. While many dengue infections are asymptomatic or produce only mild illness, the virus can occasionally cause more severe cases, and even death. Prevention and control of dengue depend on vector control. There is no specific treatment for dengue/severe dengue, and early detection and access to proper medical care greatly lower fatality rates of severe dengue.

Chikungunya is a mosquito-borne viral disease caused by the chikungunya virus (CHIKV), an RNA virus in the alphavirus genus of the family Togaviridae. The name chikungunya derives from a word in the Kimakonde language, meaning "to become contorted". Chikungunya is a disease transmitted to humans by mosquitoes in Africa, Asia, and the Americas; sporadic outbreaks have been reported in other regions. Dengue and Zika have similar symptoms to chikungunya, making chikungunya easy to misdiagnose. Chikungunya causes fever and severe joint pain, which is often debilitating and varies in duration; other symptoms include joint swelling, muscle pain, headache, nausea, fatigue and rash. There is currently no approved vaccine or specific treatment for chikungunya virus infections. Due to the challenges in reporting and diagnosis, the number of people affected by chikungunya is

underestimated. Severe symptoms and deaths from chikungunya are rare and usually related to other coexisting health problems.




Fig no. 1 Age with No. of students.




Fig no. 2 Weight for Age.




Fig no. 3 Eye Problems




Fig no. 4 Skin Problems




Fig no. 5 Common Health Problems




Fig no. 6 Dental Problems




Fig no. 7 Hair Problems

The Computer Activity Training Program conducted at Shri Manilal Nanavati Vocational Training Institute for Women was designed to enhance digital literacy and provide participants with essential computer skills needed in both academic and professional environments. The course selected for the training was MS-CIT, a widely recognized government-certified computer literacy program. The training was conducted over a duration of three months, with students attending daily sessions of one and a half hours.

The curriculum covered in this training was comprehensive and skill-oriented, ensuring that learners gained practical knowledge along with conceptual understanding. The syllabus included Windows 10 operations, Microsoft Word, Microsoft Excel, Microsoft PowerPoint, and an introduction to Artificial Intelligence (AI). Each topic was taught with a focus on hands-on learning, enabling students to apply concepts immediately during practice sessions. Students were familiarized with file management, document creation, spreadsheet handling, data analysis using Excel tools, and designing presentations using PowerPoint. The AI module gave learners an overview of modern digital tools and emerging technologies.

In addition to classroom teaching, students also completed ERA (E-Learning Resource Activity) modules. ERA consisted of a total of 50 sessions, of which 2 sessions were completed daily. These modules provided interactive content, self-learning opportunities, and assessments that strengthened students' understanding of the syllabus. Successful completion of ERA modules qualifies students for the Government MS-CIT Certification, enhancing the value of their training.

The training was effectively facilitated due to adequate infrastructure and qualified faculty. The institute accommodated 30 students, supported by 40 computers, ensuring that every learner had access to an individual workstation throughout the training period. This improved the quality of practice and reduced dependency during hands-on tasks.
