Midwives provide care to women and their babies' antenatal, postnatal and of course during childbirth. A major role of the midwife is to help the woman adjust to this life changing event. Helping her do this can be very effective on a one to one basis or in a group of women with their partners. Continuity of midwifery care is very important and beneficial to a pregnant woman and this type of care is rarely seen on medical wards. In the context of community midwifery a woman is usually with the same midwife or is familiar with other midwives in the community birthing teams throughout her pregnancy. This means the midwife will gain a greater understanding of the woman's history and birthing plan.

MKSSS BTINE'S OBGY departments organized "Midwifery skill station and hands on training" on 28/03/2024 at 10.00am till 1.00pm. The skill station was arranged for demonstration of various gynecological and obstetrical procedures to improve the skills of students and to improve their performance in clinical area. The programme was useful to improve personal qualities and skills to be a midwife, including an understanding and caring attitude.

The skills station was arranged for all final year Bsc Nursing students. All OBGY expert teachers guided us throughout this skills station.



**Introduction:**

The International Yoga Day has been celebrated annually on June 21 since 2015, following its inception in the United Nations General Assembly in 2014. Yoga is a physical, mental and spiritual practice which originated in India. The Indian Prime Minister, Narendra Modi, in his UN address in 2014, had suggested the date of June 21, as it is the longest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere and shares a special significance in many parts of the world.

According to Hindu mythology, Shiva is considered to be the originator of yoga. He is said to be the Adiyogi, the first yogi (adi = "first"). Summer solstice holds importance in the yogic culture as it is considered to be the very beginning of the yoga. Yoga was brought to the people by the "Saptarishis". This year yoga day celebrated under the theme of 'Yoga for One Earth, One Health' which means personal well-being and planetary health are deeply interconnected. "In caring for ourselves, we begin to care for Earth, reflecting the enduring Indian ethos of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam, or the whole world is one family."
