Introduction:

As a brainchild of two great institutions, the Maharshi Karve Stree Shikshan Samstha and Jnana Probodhini Medical Trust. We are the pioneers of Private Nursing Colleges in Maharashtra. Our institute started the GNM programme with twenty students in 2000. We now have 500 students studying in ANM, GNM, B.Sc., P.B.Sc., M.Sc., and Ph.D. courses in Nursing. The students will be motivated and educated to serve and discharge their duties with love and affection. Our institution is affiliated with the Indian Nursing Council, Delhi, the Maharashtra State Board of Nursing and Paramedical Education, the Maharashtra Nursing Council, Mumbai, and the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

As a pioneer institution, we are accredited by NAAC, and we have also implemented ISO systems. We are also running an Association for all Unaided Private Nursing Colleges of Maharashtra from 2008 onwards. Through this association, we have solved the issues faced by the member colleges by making representations to related authorities. Such as the central Government, State Government, INC, MNC, MSBNPE, MUHS, ARA, FRA, etc.

Faculty:

Our Institution has extensive experience and dedicated, qualified faculty. We have 32 full faculty members, with 2 members having a PhD in Nursing. 5 teachers are in the process of obtaining their Ph.D. (N), and 14 teachers have with M.Sc. (N). The Management of the college maintains the staff-student ratio as per the Indian Nursing Council norms. Staff are upgrading their knowledge by attending seminars and conferences, FDPs.

Academic plan and implementation:

The new academic year for all programs started in the month of August with orientation & Counseling of students, parent-teacher meeting, socioeconomic background survey for new students, and health checkup and vaccination of students. Induction & Orientation Program for New faculty is arranged by senior faculty. The Master Rotation plan has been planned for all years separately, and it has been implemented. Theory and clinical block are planned as a

complete block. Nursing subjects are taken by our nursing faculty & non-nursing subjects are dealt with by external lecturers.

Clinical experiences of the students:

Clinical experiences started in September. Our students gain their clinical experience in our parent hospital, Deenanath Mangeshkar Hospital, Mai Mangeshkar Hospital, some municipal hospitals like Jayabai Sutar Hospital, Kamala Nehru Hospital, Sonawane Hospital & Yerawada Mental Hospital; and Chaitanya Institute of Mental Health for the subjects of Foundations of Nursing, Medical-Surgical Nursing, Pediatric Nursing & Obstetrics and Gynecological Nursing, and Mental Health Nursing. Kamshet and Paud Primary Health Center, this area has been adopted by our college to provide primary level care & to post our students to gain experience in Community Health Nursing.

Observational and field visits:

Students have been provided opportunity to learn through different methods of teaching. Observational visits were arranged to gain knowledge by observation. We planned to go for a field visit to different areas. Such as our students from the 5th and 6th semesters of the B.Sc. program visited private and government educational hospitals, Panchayat Samiti, Block Development Office, etc. Students from the 3rd & 4th Semesters of the B.Sc. program visited the blind school, eye bank, and oncology palliative care center. Students from the 5th & 6th Semesters of the B.Sc. program visited the Mental Retardation Home, De-addiction Centre, Child Guidance Clinic, milk dairy at Katraj, Slaughterhouse, Old age home, and water purification center etc.

Examination:

The MUHS conducted examinations of semesters of the B.Sc. program every 6 months, and P.B.B.Sc., M.Sc. examinations annually in June-July, and the MSBNPE conducted ANM and GNM examinations in November. We have 90 - 100 percent results in all our programs, and some of our students are rank holders at the University and the Maharashtra Nursing Council. Student Ms. Sayali Khashilkar for standing 1st in Child Health Nursing in the first year of PBBSC Nursing at MUHS, and Ms. Mrudula Bhuvad from Semester III B. Sc (N) for MUHS merit at the Microbiology subject in the summer 2024 examination. Student Ms. Sakshi Jadhav from 1st year P.B.B. Sc for MUHS merit at the Biochemistry subject in the summer

2024 examination. Class I and II rank students and special achievements by students from other competitions were awarded in the lamp lighting function by our chief guest, and our teachers were awarded for their achievements in their teaching careers.

Conferences for nursing faculties & Faculty development programs:

MUHS MET approved workshop on Basic Research Methodology organized on 14th to 18th October 2024. The International Faculty Development & Exchange Program (FDP) on Collaborative Innovation in Nursing Education was held from 02/01/2025 to 07/01/2025 with sessions by international resource persons on Implications of AI in nursing Education, Scope of Nurse Practitioner, followed by Legal safeguards in nursing practice, followed by a MoU signed between both institutes. Participants were awarded certificates. International Research Development Conference on “Advancing Research Excellence: Strategies for High-Quality Publications” was conducted on 3rd & 4th March 2025. TOT on counseling skills- constructive leadership for the Inclusive Environment program series was arranged for faculty in April 2025. Online faculty exchange program of our institute with Mid Sweden university presentation & discussion with their PhD scholars held on 17th June 2025.

Value-added activity and add-on courses:

We believe and practice that all-round personality development of a student requires, besides education, an exposure to regular sports, extra-curricular activities, motivational lectures by experts, and dedicated annual soft skill development programs. For newcomers, first-year students of ANM, GNM, and B.Sc. programs organized First-aid course theory and demonstration sessions. International students exchange program (online) 10 sessions organized on simulation with North Harris group of nursing college USA. For the first year P.B.B.Sc., and the third year GNM organized Yoga session of seven days. Our students performed mock drill on CPR & Disaster management at MKSSSS career guidance EXPO 2024.

Lamp lighting ceremony:

We organized and conducted a Lamp Lighting and convocation ceremony on 28.03.2025, which was held in our Samstha's Ramapurushottam Auditorium with esteemed dignitaries, Honorable Dr. Ramling Mali and Smt. Smita Kulkarni and esteemed management committee members. In this ceremony, the students showed their acceptance of caring the society for their welfare and delivering health care to all human beings without any discrimination by

lighting their lamps from the respected principal through teachers. Students have taken the nursing oath for themselves on how to become quality nursing professionals of international repute.

NSS activity:

We have excellent infrastructure facilities, and our students receive quality education through exposure to theory, practical, and extra-curricular activities. They are also given keen social aptitude through NSS and community field exposure. We have an NSS unit of 50 students.

Second-year and third-year B.Sc. students enrolled as NSS volunteers, the NSS unit conducted various health awareness rallies such as Personal hygiene, Environmental hygiene, Organ donation, Gender equality, Beti Bachhao Beti Padhao, De-Addiction, Har ghar Tiranga, and Tree Plantation. The NSS unit conducts a 7-day winter camp in a rural area. We also conduct a blood donation camp in our institute and work as volunteers in a health campaign.

SNA activity:

SNA plays a major role in conducting all programs related to health & festivals. Teacher's Day, Dipostav, Fresher's Party, college cultural week, lamp lighting ceremony, National Youth Convention Day, Spandan competition, etc., were successfully celebrated by our SNA and cultural team. Our students excel not only in education, but also in sports and cultural competitions.
